

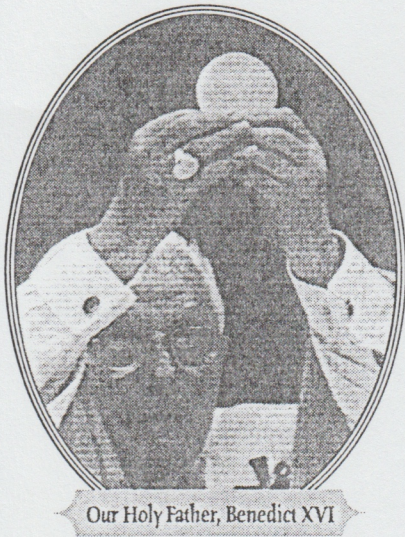
The 49th International Eucharistic Congress will be held in Québec City in 2008

This congress is one of the many celebrations marking the 400th Anniversary of the foundation of Québec by Samuel de Champlain.

Cardinal Ouellet, archbishop of Québec, has confirmed the details of the congress which will take place from **June 15th to the 22nd 2008**. Mr. Yvan Caron, ex-president of the Caisses Desjardins Federation, will be Chairman of the Congress. Some 100, 000 members of the Knights of Columbus of Québec have already made a substantial contribution of 1 million dollars. An invitation has gone out to **Pope Benedict XVI** to honor us with his presence.

ADORATION CHAPELS ARE "ON THE RISE" WORLDWIDE

"Over 2,500 parishes around the world now have perpetual eucharistic adoration. About 500 in the Philippines, the United States has about 1,100 chapels of perpetual adoration, the Republic of Ireland about 150, South Korea has about 70 and lesser numbers in India, Sri Lanka and Myanmar. If the perpetual adoration chapels were to be established in all the dioceses in the world and in all possible parishes, what a magnificent result that would be for the closing of the Eucharistic Year. This is true: until the Church cries out that Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is worthy of perpetual adoration for all He has done for our salvation, she will continue to be defeated by her enemies. I believe that the best, the surest and the most effective way of establishing peace on the face of the earth is through the great power of perpetual adoration of the Blessed Sacrament."
