## ***What is a diocesan or parish spiritual campaign?***

We are launching a spiritual campaign to increase Eucharistic adoration and adorers in our parish. It's not a fundraising campaign. We would like everyone to spend a weekly hour with Jesus in adoration. A bishop can also ask all parishes in his diocese to start or expand their regular opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration.

## ***What is Eucharistic Adoration?***

We can show our adoration to God in many ways, but in Eucharistic Adoration, we enjoy spending time adoring Jesus face-to-face since He is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, in the Blessed Sacrament.

## ***Why is this spiritual campaign important?***

Spending time in Eucharistic Adoration draws us into intimacy with Jesus. It helps us to grow in our personal relationship with Him. As we get closer to God, He gives us His love, peace, wisdom, and many graces.

## ***When does our spiritual campaign start?***

Our campaign launches on Ash Wednesday.

## ***When does our spiritual campaign conclude?***

Our campaign will conclude on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ in June. Our parish will begin our new Eucharistic Adoration schedules that week.
